Violations

1) Food Safety - Daycare

Observation: Class rooms using non testable sanitizer for food contact surfaces.

Corrective Action(s): Use a sanitizer that is able to be tested with a test strip such as bleach. Facility can use the Purell if they choose to do so but, must use the bleach/water sanitizer as a last step in the process tested to a 100 ppm concentration. (Corrected on Site)

2) Sanitary Practices

Observation: Kitchen and upstairs girls bathroom diaper changing missing bleach spray bottle Corrective Action(s): All diaper changing areas must have a sanitizer spray bottle at the changing station. (Corrected on Site)

2) Sanitary Practices

Observation: C-Room: fridge is sitting directly on the carpet.

Corrective Action(s): Refrigerators must sit on a smooth and cleanable surface.

(Corrected on Site)

3) Safety

Observation: A few outlets missing protectors.

Corrective Action(s): All outlets must have something plugged in or an outlet protector installed.

(Corrected on Site)

Comments

Dishwasher at 100 ppm.

All hand wash sinks were between 100 and 120 degrees F. Facility is allowed to use the Purell as a disinfectant but, must use a testable sanitizer such as bleach as the last step in the sanitizing process. Facility is still working on funding in order to replace carpet. Fill in holes in kitchen.

Failure to make corrections shall result in denial, suspension, or revocation of your license.

All critical violations shall be corrected within 10 calendar days. An extension may be granted if the corrective action cannot be completed within 10 days. All extensions must be in writing. Repeat violations requiring additional follow-up inspections may be subject to a \$100.00 reinspection fee.
