If three (3) or more critical violations are committed within the period of one (1) year (calendar or otherwise), the body piercing establishment permit shall be subject to revocation. Items identified as constituting imminent health hazards shall be corrected immediately or operations shall cease. You are required to post the body piercing establishment permit in a conspicuous manner and to keep this inspection report available at this facility for public discloture to any person who requests to review it. You have the right to request a review regarding this report by filing a written request with the Director of Environmental Health within ten (10) days of the date of this report. T.C.A. Sections 4-5-202, 4-5-301, 62-38-301 gt. <u>Meg.</u>, 68-2-608, and 68-2-609.
