- 5: Ice machine shoot extremely dirty located on first floor.
- 6: Ice container and liner dirty in room 207.
- *9: Live roaches observed in guest room 143 on the wall near table, in furniture drawers, and inside refrigerator. Contract a licensed exterminator to treat this guest room for roaches. A follow up inspection will be performed within 10 days to verify compliance of this critical item violation.
- 12: Trash can outside building 2 near bottom of stairs, doesn't have a lid.
- *18: Year not punched on fire extinguisher tag near guest rooms 129 and 131. Contract a licensed fire extinguisher company to check and retag fire extinguisher. A follow up inspection will be performed within 10 days to verify compliance of this critical item violation. A warning letter will be requested due to this critical item violation being noted on two consecutive inspection reports in a row.
- *18: Fire extinguisher tag expired on fire extinguisher near room 213. Contract a fire extinguisher company to check and retag fire extinguisher. A follow up inspection will be performed within 10 days to verify compliance of this critical item violation. A warning letter of permit revocation will be requested due to this critical item violation being noted on two consecutions.
- *18: Smoke detector not working in guest room 255. A follow up inspection will be performed within 10 days to verify compliance of this critical item violation. A waning letter will be requested due to this critical item violation being noted on two consecutive inspection reports in a row.
- *20: Location of guest rooms not marked on evacuation plans in guest rooms. A follow up inspection will be performed within 10 days to verify compliance of all this critical item violation.
- *20: Phone not working in guest room 131. A follow up inspection will be performed within 10 days to verify compliance of this critical item violation.
- 30: Missing vent return on ceiling in bathroom in guest room 143.
- 30: Vent return on ceiling in bathroom is hanging down in room 127.
- 31: Back side of entry doors into guest rooms are dirty.
- 32: Only 3 clothes hangers in guest room 255.
- 32: No clothes hangers in rooms 131 and 143.
- 33: Back side of cover on bed in room 115 is dirty.
- 33: Pillow case on pillow in guest room 115 stained.
- 33: Fitted sheet has hole on it in room 131.
- 33: Hole on fitted sheet in room 207.
- 33: Cover in room 255 next to wall has a hole on it.
- 33: Sheet stained on bed in room 131.
- 34: Several pillows stained in guest rooms building 2. Damaged pillow with a hole in guest room 143.
- 35: Mirror dirty in room 207.
- 35: Hole on chair in room 131.
- 35: Plastic wrap around hair dryer cord and hair dryer dirty in room 131.
- 35: Microwave plate and inside top of microwave dirty in room 115.
- 35: Black mark inside refrigerator in room 131.
- 35: Inside top and bottom of microwave dirty in room 207.
- 35: Inside microwave dirty in guest room 255.
- 35: Extremely dirty chair near sink in guest room 143.
- 36: Carpet has holes on it in room 131.

What is Legionella?

Legionella are bacteria that can cause a serious lung infection called Legionnaires' disease. People can get sick when they inhale water droplets that contain the bacteria.



How does Legionella affect building water?

Legionella bacteria grow naturally in the environment and in water. They can also grow in building water systems. Buildings with large water systems, like hotels, may be more likely to grow Legionella. If the bacteria are present, they can be spread through aerosols produced by: hot and cold water systems, showerheads, decorative fountains, hot tubs, cooling towers, and more.



Why should you care?

Legionella may grow and spread in hotel water systems. Hotels often have a large number of visitors and numerous Legionella outbreaks have occurred at hotels. From 2016 to 2017, there were 134 illnesses related to two outbreaks at Tennessee hotels.



What can you do to prevent Legionella?

You can protect your guests and staff by assessing your water system and learning about water management programs. Using a water management program can help identify hazards in your water system and prevent the growth and spread of *Legionella* bacteria.
