Complaint: Complainant stated that they stayed in room 425 at the establishment on 3/26/24. They stated that the room had roaches, stains on the bed, mold in the bathroom and stains on the towels.

Observations : Walls in room 425 have damage. No stains were observed on bedding or towels. No live roaches were observed. One dead roach observed behind refrigerator . Some mold like substance on caulking in restroom. Person In Charge stated that he has a complaint from that room and they were offered a refund.



# Your building water system and Legionella





# What is Legionella?

Legionella are bacteria that can cause a serious lung infection called Legionnaires' disease. People can get sick when they inhale water droplets that contain the bacteria.



# How does Legionella affect building water?

Legionella bacteria grow naturally in the environment and in water. They can also grow in building water systems. Buildings with large water systems, like hotels, may be more likely to grow Legionella. If the bacteria are present, they can be spread through aerosols produced by: hot and cold water systems, showerheads, decorative fountains, hot tubs, cooling towers, and more.



## Why should you care?

*Legionella* may grow and spread in hotel water systems. Hotels often have a large number of visitors and numerous *Legionella* outbreaks have occurred at hotels. From 2016 to 2017, there were 134 illnesses related to two outbreaks at Tennessee hotels.



## What can you do to prevent Legionella?

You can protect your guests and staff by assessing your water system and learning about water management programs. Using a water management program can help identify hazards in your water system and prevent the growth and spread of *Legionella* bacteria.
