You are required to post the body piercing establishment permit in a conspicuous manner and to keep this inspection report available at this facility for public disclosure to any person who requests to review it. You have the right to request a review regarding this report by filing a written request with the Director of Environmental Health within ten (10) days of the date of this report. T.C.A. Sections 4-5-202, 4-5-301, 62-38-301 gt. seq., 68-2-608, and 68-2-609.
